The building is in the middle of a park at  $3^{\rm rd}$  St. between  $4^{\rm th}$  &  $5^{\rm th}$  Ave.






I can get there by taking a train, bus, or car.

There may be lots of other children in the playground and it may be loud.




I enter the Old Stone House by walking through the wooden gates and into the red door at the front.

I will walk past the soccer field to get to the Old Stone House.




I will enter through the big red door.

If I need to use the bathroom I can go inside the office.










If I need a break during the performance, I can go back downstairs.
