

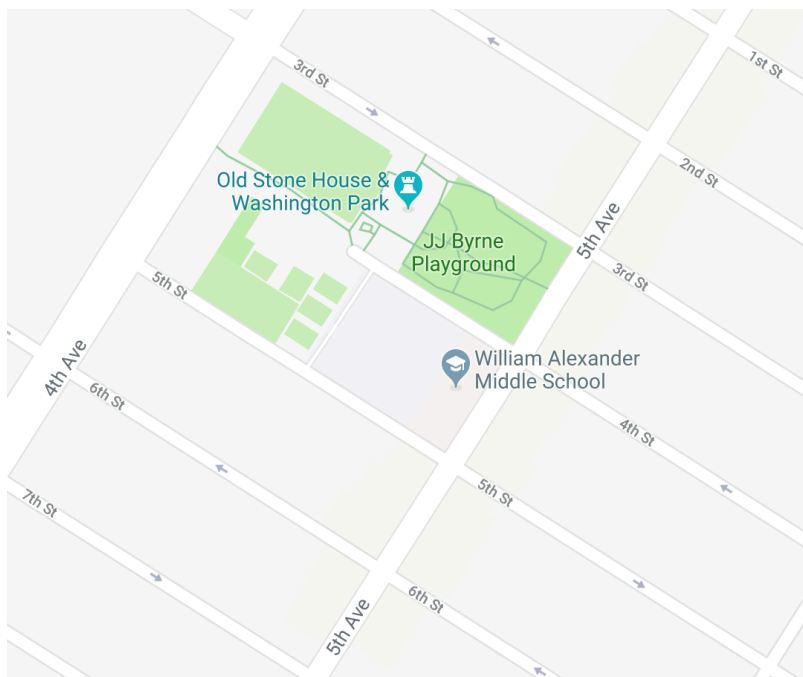


## GOING TO THE THEATRE

If I need to use the bathroom I can go inside the office.



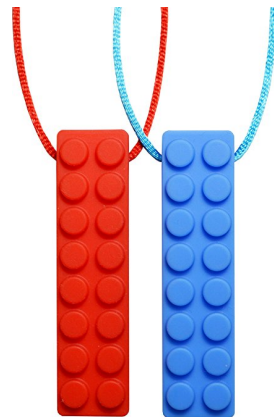




If I need a break during the performance, I can go back downstairs.
