### Inspiration:

- 1. Set up a screen free space where listening is ok.
- 2. Gather something to draw on and something to draw with (see suggestions below.)
- 3. Listen to the album titled The Reason I Like Chocolate by Nikki Giovanni.

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4. While listening, draw, color, scribble, finger paint, fold the paper or write words inspired by the poetry.

#### Connect:

#### 0-2 Years:

Let your child draw or finger paint on a piece of paper. Then call attention to specific areas in the artwork that you love or want to highlight. Frame that area by tracing your child's or your own hand on top of the area of brilliance. Feel free to add words of encouragement, empowerment, and self-love or add a title to the artwork.

#### 2-5 Years:

Use a flashlight to project the child's hand and/or body onto a larger drawing surface. Trace. Fill the shape with images, words of encouragement, empowerment and/or self-love.
